I have pleasure in offering members of the Henry Bradshaw Society the following volumes in the series *Bibliotheca liturgica danica*. Each volume provides an edition of a medieval Latin liturgical text from Denmark together with an introduction in English.

The Manual from Notmark, ed. Knud Ottosen, Copenhagen 1970, 124 pages.

Notmark is a village on the island of Als which in the Middle Ages belonged to the diocese of Odense. Besides the usual rituals for baptism, marriage, extreme unction etc., this fourteenth-century manual contains a unique long blessing of a farm to avoid plague and its annual renewal. The texts correspond to those found in the 1483 printed missal from Odense, even when those diverge from other texts, and they also show traces of influence from Evesham, from where the Cathedral Priory of Odense was founded in the eleventh century.

The Manual from Bystorp, ed. Bengt Strömberg, Egtved 1982, 133 pages.

This text survives in a single manuscript written early in the sixteenth century by the priest Per Ibsen and bound up slightly later with a copy of the printed Roskilde Manual of 1513. That book belonged to the pilgrimage church of Bystorp by Roskilde, and details in the liturgical material in the Bystorp manuscript also point specifically to the diocese of Roskilde. The Bystorp Manual contains texts and music for the Genealogies, the Blessing of Palms, the Good Friday and Easter Eve liturgies and the blessing of candles at Candlemas.
